



DESCRIPTION

Floorseal Block Paving Eco Seal is an easy to use water-based sealer. This product can be applied to old or newly laid cement/concrete-based block pavers. This sealer will seal the surface of the paver and harden sanded joints, thus inhibiting organic growth and staining. Free from solvents & VOCs, so fume free with a rapid dry formula. This product seals & protects block paving whilst producing an attractive natural finish. Can be applied in a single coat or two coats for more porous surfaces.

USES

The sealing of porous:

- · Cement-based block pavers.
- · Concrete-based block pavers.

ADVANTAGES

- · Water based.
- Low odour.
- · Rapid drying.
- · Subtle colour enhancement.
- · Inhibits organic growth.
- · Resists staining.
- · Hardens sanded joints.

COVERAGE

Approximately 2m² per litre (1st coat). 5m² per litre (2nd coat where required).

*The coverage rate will vary due to the level of porosity encountered

DIRECTIONS OF USE

- Carry out a test in an inconspicuous area.
- If you find this product is not suitable for use on your project do not continue to use.
- Pre-clean older surfaces with Floorseal Block Paving Intensive Cleaner.
- Once dry, treat the block & joint with *Floorseal Algae Remover Concentrate.
- Allow to dry (we recommend 48 hours).
- Apply the sealer when rain is not likely in the next 24 hours.
- Apply the sealer via a sprayer, watering can or roller in 2 applications.
- The 1st coat should be applied liberally, soaking the block & particularly sanded joints.
- Squeegee or roller over the surface & into the joints.
- Redistribute any pooling or puddling over the surface.
- No pools or puddles should be left on the surface.
- Apply the 2nd coat (where required) two hours later.

- The sealer should be applied more sparingly and distributed over the surface.
- Squeegee or roller over the surface.
- No pooling or puddling should be noted after the product is applied.
- Do not place furniture or park cars on the surface for at least 24 hours after sealing.
- The product fully dries in approximately 4 hours but does not fully cure for 24 hours.
- This product should only be applied when air temperatures are above 10°C and below 20°C.
- If you wish to seal a previously sealed surface contact us for advice first.
- Do not apply to clay-based block pavers or other surfaces.
- *Use Floorseal Algae Remover Concentrate as an ongoing cleaner.

CONTRAINDICATIONS

- Do not apply to damp surfaces this will result in white patches forming.
- Allow adequate drying & curing time.
- Curing will take 24 hours when applied in the correct conditions.
- Do not place furniture back on the surface, or park vehicles on the surface for 24 hours.
- Do not apply over, or into other sealers. If you are considering applying to a previously sealed surface contact us for guidance.
- Do not apply if rain is likely.
- Pre-clean existing/older block pavers with Floorseal Block Paving Intensive Cleaner for deep cleaning.
- Use Floorseal Algae Remover Concentrate as a follow up cleaner (& ongoing cleaner) to suppress weeds, algae and moss.

PACKAGING

This product is non-flammable. Store in original container in a cool dry place, out of direct sunlight. Do not allow to freeze. Keep out of reach of children.





SHELF LIFE

The maximum shelf life is 12 months. Use within 6 weeks of opening the product.

- Adjust the coverage rate to suit the level of porosity found on site.
- If brush in compounds have been used you will use less product than pavers with sanded joints.
- If resin based brush in compounds have been used pre-clean with Floorseal Sealer Residue Remover.
