Perfect for sealing, deepening colour & solidifying sanded joints. Resists damp penetration, organic growth, abrasion, solidifies sand & degradation from UV light.

USES

COVERAGE

3m² per litre for 1st coat. 4m² per litre for 2nd coat. Coverage rate will be significantly higher when sealing pavers with solid non-sanded joints.

DIRECTIONS OF USE

- Carry out a test in an inconspicuous area to check for suitability.
- Remove surface residues/hazes from cements, sand or jointing compounds.
- Where possible lightly pressure wash the surface, allow to dry for 3-5 days.
- Apply the sealer when rain is not likely in the next 24 hours.
- Apply via a low pressure pump-up sprayer or short pile roller.
- Apply the sealer to soak the block & sanded joints.
- A squeegee or roller can be used to distribute any pooling into the joints
- Apply the second coat approximately 2 hours later (if required).
- Older, previously sealed, or very dense blocks may only require one coat
- Do not walk in your work/ application area (wet sealer) whilst applying.
- Working in small sections produces optimal results.

- No pooling or puddling should be noted after the product has been applied.
- Do not place furniture or park cars on the surface for at least 24 hours.
- The product dries in approximately 2 hours and fully cures after 24 hours.
- Only apply when air temperatures are above 12°C and below 24°C.
- If you wish to seal a previously sealed surface, contact us for advice first.
- For cleaning (older dirty)
 blocks clean with Floorseal
 Block Paving Intensive
 Cleaner.
- For general maintenance cleaning, use Floorseal Green Remover Concentrate.
- If re-sanding allow the sand to slump before re-sealing.
- When re-sanding, applying a weed killer to the base of the joint is recommended.

CONTRAINDICATIONS

- Do not apply to damp surfaces or surfaces which display efflorescence salting
- · Do not apply if rain is imminent
- Do not pressure wash for 7 days after application
- Do not place furniture on the surface, or park vehicles on the surface for at least 24 hours after application
- If you are applying to a surface previously sealed with a different brand/type of product contact us for guidance
- Pre-clean existing/older dirty block pavers with Floorseal Block Paving Intensive Cleaner. Treat the joint with a weed killer. You may need to remove dead moss etc and weeds/ roots before sealing
- If re-sanding treat the base of the joint with a weed killer. If resanding allow the sand time to slump before any sealing work is carried out. Or the sand (after binding with sealer) will crack
- Allow 3-5 days drying after pre-cleaning work
- Do not walk in the product/work area whilst applying the sealer
- Do not use as a pre-grout sealer

PACKAGING

This product is non-flammable. Store in original container in a cool dry place, out of direct sunlight. Do not allow to freeze. Keep out of reach of children.

SHELF LIFE

The maximum shelf life is 24 months when stored correctly. Please agitate periodically.

SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

ADDITIONAL USER INSTRUCTIONS

- Use Floorseal Green Remover Concentrate as a follow up (ongoing) cleaner to suppress green organic growth, lichens & mould
- When re-sanding the application of a general purpose weed killer prior to applying sand (to the base of the joint) is beneficial
- For older blocks we strongly recommend using a weed killer before attempting to seal. You should remove/kill all weeds (and the roots of). If this process is not carried out effectively new weed growth can occur from existing root structures
- Wash out brushes, & rollers with white spirit whilst still wet.
 Sprayers can be rinsed through with white spirit, followed by warm water & detergent
