This durable sealer can also slightly deepen surface colours, enriching the colour within the tile. A resilient finish with a shine, suitable for external & internal tiles.

USES

- Sealing porcelain tiles to create a low sheen.
- Forms a protective barrier.
- Sealing modern porcelain patios.
- Resists dirt/organic staining.

ADVANTAGES

- Water based.
- Low odour.
- One coat application.

COVERAGE

Approximately 30m² per litre (per coat).

DIRECTIONS OF USE

- **Carry out a test in an inconspicuous area. If you find this product is not suitable for use on your project, do not continue to use.**
- All residues of grout/sand/cement/mortars/resin compounds are to be removed before sealing.
- The tiles should be clean and dry before application.
- Do not apply if rain is predicted in the following 24 hours.
- For optimal results apply with microfibre cloths. A flat microfibre mop can be used with care.
- Fold your microfibre cloth into a half & then a quarter to produce a flat square.
- Do not apply via roller, sprayer or brush.
- Apply evenly ensuring the (white) liquid has been spread over the tiles to produce a thin clear micro-coating. **Only apply this product in one coat.**
- Do not allow puddling or pooling, ensure a thin even coat is maintained.
- Typically, the surface will accept light traffic after 2 hours. Do not walk on the surface if it is still tacky.
- The product fully cures over 24 hours.
- Do not place furniture back on the surface for 48 hours.
- This product should only be applied when air temperatures are above 10°C and below 24°C.
- If you wish to seal a previously sealed surface, contact us for advice first.
- Do not apply to fully polished (highly reflective) porcelains.

CONTRAINDICATIONS

- Do not apply in more than one coat.
- Only apply with a microfibre cloth or flat microfibre mop.
- Test on a small area to check suitability.
- Only apply to dry tiles in dry conditions.
- Do not use a roller.
- Do not allow the product to puddle.
- Do not use as a pre-grout sealer.

PACKAGING

This product is non-flammable. Store in original container in a cool dry place, out of direct sunlight. Do not allow to freeze or become unduly hot. Keep out of reach of children.

SHELF LIFE

The maximum shelf life is 12 months.
Please agitate periodically. Use within 6 weeks of opening.
